

## UNT Insights Program Quick Reference Sheet



Accessing SAS VA and opening an Insights report:

- UNT SAS Visual Analytics URL: https://insights.unt.edu/
- Log in by entering unt\ followed by your EUID (unt\xxx1234) and password (same as network login).
- You will land on the home screen first. When viewing a dashboard, click the home button 🗖 in the top left corner at any time to return home.
- Use the open icon 🔎 to locate and open a dashboard file (under "SAS Folders", click on a folder under "Insights" then open a dashboard by clicking on the dashboard file in the right panel and selecting "open").
- Your dashboard folders will be listed in the right pane. Open one of the folders, select a file, and click "open."
- Click the favorites icon 🖾 to identify your favorite dashboards for quick access.
- Use the edit preferences icon 🗈 to set your initial login screen and number of items in your recent history. Please do not change anything in "global preferences." Insights dashboards are currently optimized to work best with the default theme (SAS Light).
- Click the Report Viewer icon to open Report Viewer (however, Report Viewer opens automatically when you open a dashboard file).
- Click the views icon to change the appearance of the home screen (e.g., to view thumbnails vs. a list of files and to select which menus appear on the right side of the page).
- Click the help icon role to learn how to customize your screen, access helpful SAS content on the web, and to view keyboard shortcuts.

Navigating an Insights dashboard:

- After you open a dashboard file, use the file menu File to open a new file, view and open recent files, close the current file, refresh a file, print the file to a PDF, and to perform other tasks.
- Use the help menu Help to access user guides, helpful SAS content, and to view keyboard shortcuts.
- Use the refresh icon 🔊 to refresh the content in the current file.
- Use the print report to PDF icon to print/save the current tab or multiple tabs to a PDF file.
- Use the back button it to return to the previous tab while in a dashboard. This button only appears if you click on a section link.
- Use the hide banner icon  $\square$  on the top right part of the screen to limit the screen to only dashboard content.

Using filters within Insights reports:

- Filters are part of all Insights dashboard files, allowing users to "drill down" to get more detailed information.
- Filters are sometimes shown as buttons horizontally across the top of the report (e.g., academic years or semesters), or vertically in the left or right panes (e.g., student academic levels, demographics, etc.).
- To set a filter, click on the section of a figure that you want to drill down on. If other selections on the report are linked to the filter you applied, they will change upon clicking that section.
- Care should be taken by users to look for visual clues that a filter is selected or being applied (e.g. check boxes checked on drop down lists, variables shaded when selected, or words selected by clicking on interactive word maps) as this will determine what data is being displayed in your Insights dashboard.

Data definitions and documentation:


- Data definitions are available for all Insights reports. Click on a category in a figure and select an *External link* to a variable to see the official definition.
- Links are provided for the Insights data dictionary and glossary, or click "external link" to view the SAS Business
  Data Network definition. Use the back button end to return to the Insights report.
